



## 第 22 周 靈修默想

5 月 31 日 (星期一) 經文: 馬可福音十六 14-20

1. 第 14 節, 耶穌什麼時候顯現? 為什麼事責備他們? 為什麼不信? 他們的心如何? 參看本章 9-11, 12-13; 本章 7 及 14:28。抹大拉的馬利亞、兩個門徒及主耶穌的話, 他們都不信。我祈求主, 使我相信主的話過於我的人生經驗嗎?
2. 第 15-16 節, 復活的主耶穌給門徒什麼任務? 為什麼一定要傳福音? 我的家人、親友還有那些人沒有信主? 我常常為他們禱告, 早日信主嗎?
3. 第 17 及 18 節, 信的人中間可能有什麼事發生? 第 20 節, 神蹟奇事的目的是什麼? 神蹟、醫病、趕鬼、新方言和不受毒害都是為了福音能傳開, 人相信真道。



每日靈思: 詩篇 (從本周起開始默想「詩篇」, 請信徒齊來享受靈宴)  
請先翻開聖經, 恭讀相關詩篇, 禱告, 默想經文, 然後再回答問題。

6 月 01 日 (星期二) 經文: 經文: 詩篇 1: 1-6

- 1、第 1 節, 有哪三樣不要? 我拒絕惡謀、罪惡和譏笑嗎?
- 2、第 2 節, 什麼樣的人是有福的? 第 3 節, 這棵樹, 有什麼好? 栽在哪裡? 我喜愛神的話, 常常思想, 並遵行嗎?

6 月 02 日 (星期三) 經文: 詩篇 2: 1-12

- 1、第 1-3 節, 外邦在作什麼? 第 4-6 節, 天上的主怎樣回應? 說什麼? 第 9 節, 反對主的外邦有什麼結果? 我因人的反對而信仰動搖嗎? (參徒四 25-31)
- 2、第 10-11 節, 世上的君王和審判官應當作什麼? 第 12 節, 再次怎樣勸他們?

6 月 03 日 (星期四) 經文: 詩篇 3: 1-8

- 1、第 1-2 節, 大衛遭遇到什麼困難? 第 3 節, 困難中, 他想到誰? 耶和華和他有什麼關係? 遭遇困難時, 我想到誰? 我相信神能使我脫離困境, 反敗為勝嗎?
- 2、第 4 節困難中, 大衛作什麼? 耶和華怎樣回應? 第 5 節, 對他有什麼幫助? 我因神的應許放下重擔嗎? 我能安然入睡嗎?

6 月 04 日 (星期五) 經文: 詩篇 4: 1-8

- 1、第 1 節, 大衛怎樣形容神? 對神曾有什麼經歷? 第 2 節, 遇到什麼困難? 第 3 節, 他的敵人應該知道什麼事? 第 4 節, 應當怎樣行? 我相信神能使我寬廣嗎?
- 2、第 5 節, 應當作什麼? 第 6 節, 許多人希望得著什麼? 大衛祈求什麼? 結果如何?

6 月 05 日 (星期六) 經文: 詩篇 5: 1-12

- 1、第 1 節, 大衛祈求什麼? 第 3-6 節, 為什麼神必聽他祈求的聲音? 第 7 節, 他相信什麼? 我祈求神保守我的言語和思想嗎?
- 2、第 8 節, 大衛為自己求什麼? 第 9 節, 仇敵有什麼罪惡? 第 10 節, 求神作什麼? 在惡人中, 我求神使我走義路嗎? 我求神伸張公義, 或自己報復?

Week 22  
THE COMING KINGDOM  
Bible Reading: Isaiah 35:1-10

We thought together yesterday of the personal or present aspect of the phrase "Thy kingdom come". Today we look at it from another perspective - the prophetic aspect.

The Word of God leaves no doubt that ultimately Jesus Christ will not only be king over the earth, but over the whole universe. Many passages in both Old and New Testaments affirm this repeatedly.

Before Christ was born the angel Gabriel said to the Virgin Mary, "His kingdom will never end." (Lk 1:33) What did the Father say to the Son? "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet." (Ps 110:1)

What has God said to the world? "At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth ..." (Php 2:10)

When we pray "Thy kingdom come" we are praying as John did in the last words of Revelation - "Come Lord Jesus". "Come and reign over us. Take Your place on the throne of the universe.

Throw out for ever the prince of darkness and rule in righteousness. Come King Jesus and come quickly."

We cannot have the kingdom without the king, and when He does come, how wonderful it will be.

Can you imagine a kingdom of righteousness? A kingdom where there is no sin, no sickness, no corruption, no death, not even temptation? It is beyond our comprehension. This is what Christ's kingdom will be like. As individual members of Christ's kingdom, all this will be our experience when God's promises to His Son are ultimately fulfilled. We can look forward to it because of the certainty of God's Word. Are you ready for the coming of the King?
